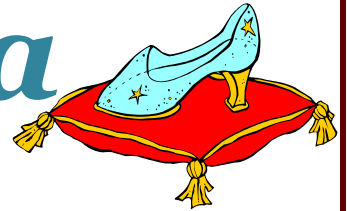


TEACHER INFORMATION - THEMED TOURS



Cinderella



Come to the fairy tale Mansion and meet our special hosts.

This tour will be themed around the fairytale world of Cinderella, The Tatton Education Team take on the role of characters from the Cinderella story. The children can come in fairytale party wear as guests for Prince Charming's ball.

Aims of the tour:

- For children to bring a familiar story to life through empathy and cultural context.
- For children to explore differences in society and behaviours, learning through story and dance.
- For children to understand how imaginative narratives are rooted in real experience.

Features of the Tour:

- Reliving and sharing the story in the Grand Staircase Hall.
- Tour of the state rooms, explaining how the Prince grew up in lonely luxury.
- Tour of the servants' quarters, explaining how Cinderella used to work: the children can do dusting or brushing as Cinderella did in the story.
- Dancing at 'The Ball' in the Marble Entrance Hall, which requires preparation in advance. The children must practise to music before the visit and bring the music with them. We have a CD/Cassette player. Suggested music is 'The Blue Danube' or a similar waltz.

Logistics:

- The maximum number for a Cinderella tour is 15 children per group, and 4 groups, so a maximum per day of 60 children.
- If the children bring a packed lunch, a lunch/base room can be provided for self guided activities.
- If you are with a large group and you have time before or after your session, then take the opportunity to develop your own self guided activities. You could visit the adventure playground; Complete the Prince Charming Stable yard Trail; Use colouring in sheets (please provide your own pencils) Colour in visit the gardens (Garden visit subject to group booking charges or Free of charge to National Trust schools)
